

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This product is used to treat **in aqua cleaning and in laundry** the stains of red fruits, wine, coffee, tea, fruit juice, colas, alcoholic drinks, chocolate, spices: curry, cumin, curcumin, saffron. As well as henna and hair dyes.

MANUAL:

TANIN+ is completely soluble regardless of water temperature. Its suspending effect will be optimized at a temperature ranging from 10 °C to 76 °C. For effective treatment of stains at given temperatures, it can be obtained during a normal washing cycle or aqua cleaning after stain removal. If the soil conditions are extreme, a longer and repeated cycle may be necessary. IN PRE-SOAKING: TANIN+ can be used as a pre-soak solution. For heavily soiled laundry, an overnight pre-soak will be recommended.
